European Water Stewardship (EWS) offers a **legitimate tool and practical guidance** to water users on their journey to becoming a Water Steward. The EWS system provides criteria for sustainable water management and protection of the water source, improving the efficient use of water and incorporating these aspects into a long term management strategies. **You can be a part of it!**

This initial training is a compulsory first step to becoming an **EWS Approved Certification Body** or an **EWS Recommended Consultant**, which will allow auditors to certify their clients against the EWS standard and consultancy organizations to provide gap analysis and trainings on the EWS system to their networks.
